CUSTOMIZE YOUR CARRY

The 3.5 is designed with customizable cant, ride height and retention. Fine-tune your holster in seconds.

WEARING YOUR IWB HOLSTER

Ensure your firearm is unloaded and safe prior to the following steps.

We recommend you wear this holster at **the 4:30 position** (above the back pocket). To carry concealed, pick a location where it lies flat against your body.

Warning: To avoid personal injury, do not wear your IWB holster at the 6 o'clock (small of back) position.



1 Position your holster.

Leave your pants unbuttoned and unzipped. Insert the holster into the front of your pants, then slide the holster around to your desired location.



2 Secure the clips.

Pinch the tab on each holster clip and pull it over your belt. Button and zip your pants, then buckle your belt. Tug on the holster to ensure the clips are securely fastened.



3 Holster your handgun.

Carefully and slowly, insert the pistol and make sure there is no clothing or obstruction in the holster that can catch the trigger. Tuck your shirt in or drape the fabric over the holster.



CUSTOMIZE YOUR CARRY

Your Cloak Tuck 3.5 is designed with a variety of customizable features. With just a few quick adjustments, you can fine-tune this holster to match your personal carry style.

Cant is the angle your handgun is pointed. Adjusting your cant will require you to detach the clips from the holster base. Remove the clips by positioning them 180° downward, then pull straight out.

For a **forward cant**, raise the front clip, lower the back clip, or do both. For a **rearward cant**, lower the front clip, raise the back clip, or do both.

Ride height is how high or low the holster sits on your belt. To raise the ride height, lower both clips. To lower the ride height, raise both clips.



Retention controls how tight the holster grips your handgun. To increase the retention, tighten the screws that attach the outer shell to the holster base. We have supplied a bag of extra hardware, including screws and spacers of various lengths, which will allow for further retention adjustment.

Attention: To prevent loosening over time, apply a dab of medium retention threadlocker such as blue Loctite or clear nail polish to your screws after customizing your retention.



CARRYING TIPS

1 Follow the four rules of gun safety.

- 1 Treat every gun as if it's loaded.
- 2 Never point your firearm at anything you are not willing to destroy.
- 3 Keep your finger off the trigger until you intend to shoot.
- 4 Be sure of your target and what's beyond it.

2 Practice, practice, practice.

Be sure to practice drawing your firearm while wearing your holster just as you would in a real-life scenario. Ensure your firearm is unloaded and safe before practicing your draw.

3 Achieve the perfect draw.

Many factors can affect the quality of your draw, it will take some customization to get it right for you.

- angle
- firearm model
- retention
- carry position

4 Wear the proper gear.

Be sure to wear a sturdy gun belt for support.
